The Memorial Site

The Comstock Township Firefighter's Memorial is built on the former site of the Comstock Fire Department's Central Fire Station. This Station was constructed in 1950 and served as the townships central fire station for 60 years. This facility was originally constructed to function as both the township hall, as well as, a fire station. Later, it also served as the living quarters of the departments fire chief and his family. The station proudly served the township until 2010 when the new central station at 1960 River St. was built.

Today, the Memorial stands at this historic site as a tribute to and a reminder of the service and sacrifice made by members of the Comstock Township Fire Department past and present, who have bravely served with honor, dignity and devotion.
